Hurricane Sandy after action report

This agency started monitoring the status of Hurricane Sandy as early as Monday, October 22. At that point the track was uncertain, but the possibility existed that it might affect our area.

As time progressed, and the likelihood of local impact increased, we started to take additional preparatory steps.

The ambulance was in good running order and fully equipped. Fuel status was confirmed. Maintenance scheduled for Monday, October 29 was postponed.

From 6am Monday, October 29 and throughout the storm, the ambulance was staffed with a Paramedic level staff.

Conditions were monitored throughout the day by mass media, local radio communications, and area radio communications. Interaction and coordination between FD, PD, Highway, and Emergency Management was ongoing.

Call volume during the storm and subsequent power outages – 1 carbon monoxide alarm due to a generator running in a garage. All residents checked.

During the balance of the week, the department continued interaction with EMS, PD, Highway, and Emergency Management as well as National Grid.

There were no injuries to personnel. There was no damage or loss to the ambulance or equipment.
