

7. Implementation Plan

Introduction

This chapter outlines the proposed Master Plan Implementation Plan. An Implementation program is one of the elements stipulated in the Massachusetts law governing master plans. The Implementation plan should define and schedule the specific municipal actions necessary to achieve the objectives of each element of the master or study plan. Scheduled expansion or replacement of public facilities or circulation system components and the anticipated costs and revenues associated with accomplishment of such activities shall be detailed in this element. This element shall specify the process by which the municipality's regulatory structures shall be amended so as to be consistent with the master plan.

The Master Plan Committee recommends that the Planning Board, together with the Select Board, establish an Implementation Committee that will follow up on the goals, objectives and action items detailed in this Master Plan.

The remaining pages of this chapter provide an Implementation Matrix that identifies the action items from the chapters of the Master Plan. A key to the abbreviations used in the Matrix appears below.
