Honorable Board of Selectmen,

On February 7th, I attended Chiefs In-service training at the Boylston Academy. I was certified in CPR and First Responder. This was a full day class.

On February 9th, Officer White and I participated in a "lock down" drill at Tantasqua Regional Senior and Juniors High Schools. Members of the Sturbridge Police Department and Massachusetts State Police also participated in the drill. These drills are usually conducted twice each school year.

On February 14th, I attended a District Attorney's Round Table discussion at Tantasqua Regional Senior High. This is a round table discussion involving local school administration, local police officers, members of the Worcester County District Attorney's Office and juvenile probation officers. This month's topic was social media sites and the dangers associated with them.

On February 15th, Officer White and I attended the MOMS Club meeting at the library to announce that the Department received 30 child safety seats from the Jeppson Grant that are available to area residents free of charge.

On February 16th, from 6pm to 7pm, Sgt. Pariseau and I attended a Pizza Night at the Library to discuss bullying with residents of Brookfield. We will be holding seven of these events in conjunction with the Library through the month of August. The funds for these events were

acquired from the Brookfield Community Club via a grant. Each of the seven nights will be open to Brookfield families and will consist of an open forum to discuss topics that are affecting families/children such as bullying, social media safety, cell phone safety, peer pressure and other topics. Free pizza is provided to the attendees.
