Background

• Part of a **competitive** Community Development Block Grant (CDBG); funding depends on continued grant availability

•Housing program is implemented on Town's behalf by **the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission (PVPC)** in partnership with
the Central Mass. Regional Planning Commission (CMRPC)

Program Design

- •15 year deferred payment **loan program** up to \$35,000 per housing unit; \$40,000 if project includes lead paint abatement, historic preservation, septic system work, or handicapped access
- •Loans never require repayment if the home is not sold within loan period; inheritance alone does NOT trigger repayment
- •If home is sold during loan period, **repayment is pro-rated** based on the client's age and the remaining time on the loan
- Each loan is secured by a lien filed with the Registry of Deeds
- Work is completed by licensed private contractors

Who is Eligible? How Do I Apply?

- •Low- to moderate-income homeowners anywhere in town
 - •1 person household: \$55,350 or less yearly income
 - •2 person household: \$63,250 or less yearly income
 - •4 person household: \$79,050 or less yearly income
- Projects will be selected in batches by **lottery** as funds become available; verified emergencies may be addressed first

Eligible Rehabilitation Activities

- •Code-related repairs (building code or sanitary code) are addressed first, but many activities are eligible:
 - •Roof repair or replacement
 - •Septic system replacement or sewer connection
 - Window and door replacement
 - Painting and siding
 - •Plumbing and electrical upgrades
 - New hot water heater or furnace
 - Abatement of lead and asbestos
 - •Structural repairs
 - Handicapped access work
 - •Weatherization/energy efficiency
 - Other work...
- •Emergency repairs are possible pending confirmation of need by Town inspectors; emergencies may jump to front of wait list
- Assistance is provided to develop the scope of work & to bid work to qualified contractors
